## TEAM UNIFORM/JERSEY GUIDELINES

Below are examples of uniforms and the required patch placement. **ALL TEAMS** must match the below patch placement & **MUST** attach the patches to your uniform before you get to Fiji.

**PLEASE NOTE:** The number patch located on the back of the uniform will no longer be required.

## **TEAM UNIFORM/JERSEY GUIDELINES**

Each team will be mailed the following:

- 20 country flag patches (located on left arm above team number)
- 20 small Eco-Challenge logo patches (on front right side of upper chest)
- 20 small team number patches (located on left arm, below the flag)
- 20 small sponsor patches (more information will be coming on this)
- TOTAL PATCHES PER TEAM = 80 PATCHES per team

**We suggest teams get the patches professionally attached or use a commercial grade sewing machine so they remain intact/attached throughout the race.**



## **TEAM UNIFORM/JERSEY GUIDELINES REMINDER**

**Please note: This information was originally shared in Newsletter #4. It has been updated to reflect the previous page.**

The schematics for the uniforms have been shared on the previous page, below are the team uniform guidelines:

- We encourage 3-4 sets of uniforms per team member.
- All teams will be given enough patches for FOUR sets of uniforms per 5-person team.
- We suggest teams get the patches professionally attached or use a commercial grade sewing machine so they remain intact/attached throughout the race.
  - Patches that come off cannot be left on the course.
- You are required to match the patch placement example on page 1.
- **All teams must attach the patches to your team uniform before you get to Fiji.**
- **All five team members must have matching uniforms.**
  - We encourage originality with the color of your uniforms. Do something that identifies your team.
  - Patterns may be allowed, but must be pre-approved by MGM/Amazon.
  - However, no logos, artwork or graphics are allowed. This includes any personal and third-party intellectual property. If you are unsure about whether something may be not be allowed, please ask in advance!
- All team uniforms must be approved by MGM/Amazon. Please submit your team uniform mock up to Ashley no later than **JULY 19.**

**Please note: if your team uniform isn't approved you will not be able to wear it during the race.**

## **THIRD PARTY CLOTHING/GEAR ACCESSORIES:**

- Logos or other third-party IP on clothing, accessories, gear, etc. should be avoided as much as possible or kept to a minimum. We are okay with small incidental logos as long as the use is not defamatory and the product is being used as intended.
- If we get any clothing or gear sponsor for the race, then restrictions may change depending on the deal that is worked out. Teams will be informed of any such restrictions.

## **TEAM UNIFORM/JERSEY FAQ'S**

**Q: Will we have to wear the uniform over our rain jackets or PFD's?**

**A: NO.** You will wear your rain jackets and PFD's over your uniform when needed.

**Q: The newsletter says: "no logos, artwork or graphics are allowed". Does this mean that no team logos can go on our race clothes/hats, etc.?**

**A: Correct,** during the race, no team logos can go on other race clothes/hats etc. This includes NO sponsor logos. Logos or other third-party IP on clothing, accessories, gear, etc. should be avoided as much as possible or kept to a minimum. We are okay with small incidental logos as long as the use is not defamatory and the product is being used as intended.

**Q: Can we wear our team logos on hats/clothing around the hotel before/after the race?**

**A: What you wear around the hotel before & after the race is up to you.**

**Q: What constitutes a uniform? Is it the same as in years past where the uniform can be as simple as a mesh shirt that is pulled over whatever clothes we are wearing, or are you meaning that shirts/pants/cycling pants/jackets all need to match for all members and that constitutes the uniform?**

**A: The shirt (uniform) is the only piece of clothing that needs to match.** Guidelines and examples are on page 1. Please note these examples are just suggestions. The uniform can be any type of shirt that your team prefers. We suggest to go for bold colors!

**Q: Does the Team Assistant Crew (TAC) also wear the uniform?**

**A: YES.**

**Q: Will we need to put patches on our waterproof jackets and warm clothing?**

**A: NO.** The patches will only be on the above uniform.

**Q: Do the uniforms need to be custom?**

**A: NO.** They can be whatever your team wants. If you'd like to make a custom uniform you are welcome to. OR if you'd like to purchase regular shirts that all match that is also an option. All team uniforms must be approved by MGM/Amazon. Please submit your team uniform mock up to Ashley no later than JULY 19.
